San Antonio FRC to Host Father's Dinner, Former NFL Player to Speak

SAN ANTONIO, TX — (February 14, 2011) The Cal Farley's San Antonio Family Resource Center will host its annual Father & Family Night. This year's guest speaker is former Dallas Cowboy's player, Alexander Wright.

The event will take place at Fuddruckers, located at I-10 and Wurzbach in the Colonade Shopping Center, on Sunday, February 20, at 6 p.m. Fathers who attend the monthly Cal Farley's Family Resource Center (FRC) meetings are encouraged to bring their families for a night out with dad. (Please note: this event is not open to the public.)

The San Antonio-based Cal Farley's FRC provides a year-round outreach service to fathers which includes hosting a monthly luncheon and networking meeting. Fathers meet the first Monday of each month at the Fuddruckers mentioned above to learn more about fathering their families. Guest speakers address various topics on fatherhood such as conflict resolution, healthy boundaries, positive discipline, single parenting, money management and blended families. Local family agencies that provide services to fathers also regularly attend, and often bring fathers they service, too. Fuddruckers provides a discount for the fathers attending these monthly meetings.

The guest speaker for this 2011 Father & Family Night event, Alexander Wright, played wide receiver for the Dallas Cowboys for several of his seven years in the NFL. Wright now serves communities around Texas as a coach, athletic director and minister. He also is a regular speaker to fathers about male responsibility and the significant impact of fatherhood.
